



The parent's role during the party

The room is decorated, the food prepared for you, the children entertained and all the mess cleaned up for you at the end but there is just a little left for you to do.

- Please advise your guests to come in clothes appropriate for dance and play activities and to wear dance trainers or trainers or pumps. Children with other foot wear such as little heels or slip-ons will mean the whole group has to remove shoes to avoid sprains.
- Greet your guests and take any parents numbers in case the unlikely event of an emergency.
- It is the parents of the birthday child's responsibility to take care of any children who leave the party room for any reason during the party such as to go the toilet etc.
- It is also the parent's responsibility to supervise children during meal time, and for younger children (under 8's) parents are recommended to dish out food for the children rather than the children serve themselves.
- If you would like us to sing happy birthday with the birthday cake please have the candle's on the cake ready before the children's party tea which takes place halfway through the party, as we sing happy birthday just after the children have finished eating to give you time during the final part of the party to cut the cake up ready for party bags.
- If any children struggle to dress themselves up the parent's can help them but unfortunately we can not.
- At the end of the party it is your responsibility to ensure all children are collected safely by the correct parents.
